EU/EEA citizens do not require a study permit to enter or study in Norway. However, they must register at <a href="www.udi.no">www.udi.no</a> (The Norwegian Directorate of Immigration) prior to arrival in order to finalize their permit registration after arrival.

Non-EU/EEA citizens must apply for a temporary residence permit for educational purposes prior to arrival to Norway. As per 01.01.2021 the cost to apply for a study permit is 4900 NOK.
